We try to keep costuming costs low, but it becomes increasingly difficult as many of us (and parents as well) do not sew and costumes that may be purchased at department stores, etc. are becoming increasingly more expensive and offer limited sizing. Often the teachers must pay for the costumes "up front" out of their own pockets and collect the money from the students. Many of the teachers order costumes off of the internet now as it is easier and more accessible than searching "on foot" which they must do on their own time. **Please take this into consideration when you are purchasing your child's costume from their teacher(s).***
