



USask Mask Policy

Updated September 17, 2021

Indoor mask requirement extended for indoor and outdoor recreation on campus.

All USask Rec patrons are **required to wear 3-ply single-use masks in all indoor and outdoor recreational spaces** on USask campuses. This includes faculty, staff, students, visitors, spectators, and community members.

If you are entering the Physical Activity Complex or Education Building for recreation activity, you will be able to retrieve a 3-ply mask **free of charge** at the front desk. We ask that you please wear your own mask indoors until you can retrieve the provided 3-ply mask.

Masks are required while participating in recreational programs at all outdoor locations on USask campuses.

For Campus Recreation, this means that **effective immediately** our patrons and our staff will be **required to wear 3-ply masks while participating in [Campus Recreation intramurals](#) outdoors on the USask campus**. We anticipate more than 20 student participants, substitutes, staff, officials, on-site supervisors, and spectators at games so this applies to our intramural programs, no exceptions.

Your compliance with this is appreciated and we hope you understand that by following this protocol not only are you protecting yourself and other, but also ensuring that our recreation programs continue to operate and provide opportunities to the USask community.
